When packing for your stay at the Home of Grace please be aware that there is limited storage space. You may bring ten (10) outfits, including your church clothes. Any more than this will be returned to your family or put in our clothes closet. If your family brings any clothing items to you during your stay, you must send back an equal number of items with them.

Cigarettes if you smoke. No e-cigarettes. No patches.

Toiletries: Shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste/toothbrush, disposable razors, soap, lotion, non-alcohol mouthwash. 2 towels/2 wash cloths

NO PERFUME

Hair Products: blow-dryer, curling iron, pump hairspray (no aerosol), make-up (if you choose to wear it).

Personal Hygiene items (3 monthly cycles)

Casual Clothing:

Shirts must be modest. No mid-drifts or suggestive messages on shirts. Tank tops must be at least 3 fingers wide, no spaghetti straps.

Jeans, slacks, capris, shorts must be knee length, no tight fitting pants, no tights or leggings.

Dresses must be knee length and no strapless or spaghetti straps.

Tennis shoes, sandals, and appropriate shoes for church.

Modest night clothing and a bed pillow if you desire.

Sunday Dress: Dress or nice pants suit only. Shoes appropriate for Church. No leggings.

Envelopes, stationary, stamps (you may write and receive letters upon your arrival).

Highlighters, loose leaf paper, small flashlight

Bible, AA or NA book if you have one. No other reading material will be accepted.

CD player with headphones, no radio and AA batteries.

1 case of bottled water (flavor packets if you desire them), 1 bag of hard candy, 1 bag of chocolate. All other snacks and drinks must be purchased from the vending machine on campus.

Money for snacks and sodas will be kept in the Housemother's safe. Clients are allowed up to \$5.00 per day. We cannot cash checks or money orders.

No cell phones, beepers, books, magazines, games, and personal vehicles may not be left on campus.

Medical/Dental: We are not a medical facility. All preexisting medical or dental matters must be taken care of prior to your arrival. If medical, dental or psychological conditions occur during the client's recovery and cannot be taken care of on campus, the client will be asked to postpone treatment until after completion of program. A medical leave/discharge may be necessary.

Legal Obligations: Court dates must be postponed prior to admission. Applicants entering the program without notifying the court or probation officer in advance may be disqualified and made to leave the program. If a client leaves the program or is dismissed the court and or probation officer will be notified upon their departure.
